Another exciting moment for me this past month was teaching at our Every Nation Dublin's Discipleship Day! The session I had the privilege of teaching on was our pattern for how to lead small groups. It was a fun day and a wonderful time getting to know the leaders and intern leaders throughout this day.



This month has also been a very hard one as well...A few weeks ago our founding pastor of Every Nation London lost his battle with cancer. Wolfi (Wolfgang) was a spiritual father and mentor to me over the past 21 years. 2 ½ years ago he was

diagnosed with stage 4 cancer and given months to live. Many of you joined us in prayer for a miracle in his body and even though it wasn't the miracle we wanted – we still got an incredible miracle of him living over 2 years longer than the doctors expected. In the natural he shouldn't have been able to walk, travel all over the world and even write another book in the last few months of his life but miraculously he did!
